KRUM DE LA KRUM was well placed early, while on the inside in the far turn with a long drive in the stretch but prevailed late in the final stages. SONOMA SUNSET was unhurried early, angled into the five path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch with a long drive but was outfinished late. BOLD PEAKS was back early, angled off the rail in the far turn but couldn't sustain the bid in the stretch drive. BOB'S LIT'L MISS set the pace early, angled off the rail in the far turn and gave way in the stretch run. DUSTY SUSIE trailed the field early, fanned into the eight path in the far turn and moved up in the stretch. POLISH FIRE tracked the pace early, angled into the three path in the far turn and faded late. CRAFTY GREY swung into the seven path in the far turn while no threat late. IMISSWHAT'SISNAME stalked the pace early, angled into the five path in the far turn with no late bid in the stretch run. SUPERIOR COURT raced up close early, swung into the six path in the far turn and soon retreated. FANCY GAL had early speed then folded up.
