LEGATANGO close up and four wide, took command at the quarter pole, drew clear at the three sixteenth pole and increased his margin there after while being kept to the task. SCATTER SHOT fractious in the gate, tracked the early pace off the rail, bid three wide into the stretch, held position, could not threat the winner but was clearly second best. CLASSICAL RHYTHM mid pack and inside, bid five wide into the stretch, then could not gain in the late going but held the show spot safe. SEE YOU CART trailed the field in the early going, came through traffic in the stretch and continued well enough to gain a share. A J'S PAYDAY improved his position. PUT UP OR close up and three wide, made a middle move and came up empty. I LOVE VEGAS was no factor. ROCK PULPIT vied for the early lead inside, then had no rally. RUNNOFT set the early pace outside, then came up empty nearing the lane.
