Footnotes

ABSOLUTE CHARM, void of early foot, rallied between horses and just edged BADASIWANTABE. The latter, four wide, challenged on the turn, gained the advantage turning for home and was just caught. THISONEFORME, four wide on the turn, lacked the needed late response. SALTINESS dueled early between horses, steadied in tight quarters into the turn, then weakened in the drive. CELESTIAL WARRIOR dueled inside early, then faded. MY KEWPI DOLL lacked a late bid. NORTHERN LODGE dueled for early command between foes, then faded in the drive. OVERNIGHT EXPRESS, outside, gained a narrow lead before the first quarter, then had nothing left for the drive. HIGBEE was outrun.
