Footnotes

M'NAUGHTEN sprinted clear soon after the start, increased his margin through the turn, drew off in the stretch while being kept to the task. CINCO ESTRELLA tracked the early pace inside, gained a striking position on the rail through the turn, angled out in the stretch for clear racing room, close well but could not threaten the winner while best of the rest. BLUE RYDER RED rushed up to contention four wide, angled to five wide to bid into the stretch, held the show safe while no threat to the top two. CRAFTY SCOUT well back and inside, gained position into the stretch, had a mild gain in the lane and missed the show in the final strides. SMOKIN' EXPRESS well placed three wide, gained a striking position through the turn, held position in the stretch but lacked the late response needed. MAJOR POINT stalked the pace outside, kept position to the lane, faded in the drive. TWOHOOTSANDAHOLLAR bumped hard by a rival at the start, was no factor. ULTIMATE TRICK was never involved. J T 'S COPPERLINE broke in badly at the start to impede rivals inside, bumped TWOHOOTSANDAHOLLAR, was hard to handle and could not menace.
