Footnotes

AMY AGAIN was urged from the break to take command racing along the rail into the turn, set the pace to the far turn, dispatched some rivals while drifting out markedly leaving the furlong pole but prevailed under steady right handed encouragement. MILLIES MOTION lacked early pace while unpressured in the opening quarter, saved ground to the lane while gradually gaining contention, split foes in mid stretch and made a belated effort to secure second approaching the wire. MERELY MONEY, forwardly placed between foes racing into the first turn, was taken in hand on the backstretch to stalk just off the first flight along the rail, continued in that path to the lane but could not menace further while finishing evenly in late stages. WHISPER AND RUN broke inwards and bumped ADIF, was urged to join the pacesetter while caught three deep on the first turn, continued to force the pace for six furlongs and gave way entering the stretch. ADIF, bumped at the start, was quickly collected and urged to gain a striking position, advanced outside to press the pace three wide into the far turn and emptied out midway through that bend. CARLA SPARKLES was reserved from the outset and never gained contention.
