SILK SAILS was unhurried early, rallied, was all out to get up in final strides. DEMITRYST was in a good striking position, rallied, lost ground on the turn, took the lead late but was outfinished. EASY ACTION dueled between horses, led between calls but weakened late. PRINCESS AMANDA dueled between horses, gained command in upper stretch, but then gave way. SWEET DIXIE well placed, rallied, was steadied upper stretch, and then faltered. RHAPSODY AT SEA was well placed in the middle of the pack evenly with no rally. ENDING WELL showed brief speed, inside, gave way. WIRED TO FLY set the pace inside, but then gave way. WILDWOOD PENNY failed to menace.
