ORNERY was hustled from the start, contested the pace, inched clear on the far turn and drew off then was in hand late. JUST FOR GIGGLES settled on the inside, advanced on the far turn, drifted in near the furlong marker and proved no match for the winner while clear for the place. MR. ROAD WARRIOR raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed, chased inside on the far turn and weakened. SUPER FREDI broke outward and was off slow, raced well back in the field and failed to respond. WHISKEY AND GRITS was hustled from the start then urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the far turn, bumped with a rival in upper stretch and came up empty. DO YOU SEE ME NOW raced five wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, bumped with a rival in upper stretch and tired. ALMOST LEGENDARY was fractious in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn and was no factor. CHARLIE'S LEOPARDO steadied while in tight on the first turn, saved ground towards the rear and failed to reach contention. LONE STAR GENERAL raced four wide on the first turn and stopped.
