**Footnotes**

PRYING KING raced three wide on the first turn, was hard ridden at the rear of the field, passed rivals while three wide on the far turn, was forced out near the furlong marker and closed strongly to win going away. U CAN BANK ON IT set the clear pace under a long hold, responded well when set down, remained clear into the final furlong but tired and was caught. SPEEDY ASSEMBLY settled on the inside, moved closer near the half-mile pole, chased inside on the far turn and lacked the needed kick while able to secure the show. Z BEYOND FAME lingered well back in the field, advanced outside near the half-mile pole, was hard ridden while four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. CHASE N CARTER was caught four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and tired. TWO JAYS SECRET was caught four wide on the first turn, raced up close to the pace, chased while off the rail on the far turn and faded. DANDY bumped with a rival at the start, raced up close to the pace, came up empty on the far turn and retreated. A SPLASH OF TOUR raced three wide on the first turn, steadied near the three-quarter pole and was through early. NOBLE RIBBLE broke inward and bumped with a rival, raced well back in the field and was outrun. BEWARE OF THE PHOG raced three wide on the first turn and showed little.
