TASTE OF HADIF vied for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then drew off in upper stretch and was kept to a drive late. DANCINGWITHPASSION was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the turn, was gaining ground and was second best while no threat to the winner. LADY J J was unhurried early then rallied on the inside, was blocked in mid stretch then angled out, split rivals and was gaining ground late. BRAZOS SHUTTLE was unhurried early then made a late rally on the inside but was no threat. IF I HAD was bumped at the start then was no factor. MANZOTTINA dueled for the lead from the outside, was hard used and gave way in the stretch. IDE BET IT ALL failed to menace. KATY BLONDE chased the pace while two wide and gave way on the turn. ROAN CAT chased the pace while three wide, was used up and stopped. DUST PEBBLE was bumped at the start then ducked in and hit the temporary rail knocking it down then was outrun and eased up in late stretch.
