PLAY THE CHIME set the early pace while being well rated, was sat down into a strong drive on the far turn then gamely dug in throughout the stretch drive and held sway in deep stretch. DUSTY TUNNEL stalked the pace while inside on the run down the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then came out two wide for the stretch drive, was gaining ground in late stretch but missed in the end. BANQUO was settled on the run down the backstretch then started a run going into the far turn, rallied strongly then swung out four wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch to finish well. P. L. GOLD was unhurried early then saved ground on the far turn and made a bid along the inside in the stretch then hung in late stretch. TRU DANCING was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while four wide then made a bid to upper stretch and came up empty in the stretch. LIGHT SOURCE (IRE) stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch then made a bid near the half mild pole then faltered in the stretch. BLUMIN CRAFTY bobbled at the start then was well placed while two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive.
