J W FLYER was stalking the early pace while racing two wide into the turn, rallied four wide at the top of the stretch, was in a strong drive and proved best in the end. FLASHAHOLIC was unhurried early then rallied on the turn while two wide, closed fast along the inside in late stretch and finished strong. BAD AS BANDINI was unhurried early then started a run on the turn and swung out to be eight wide in upper stretch, closed with a rush but was too late. BULLRED was allowed to settle then rallied on the turn while four wide, was gaining ground in late stretch but was came up empty in the end. MARDI GRAS MAN vied for the lead while four wide, was in a long drive then tired in late stretch. LATENT PROSPECT vied for the lead while three wide, was in a long drive but tired in deep stretch. NOBIZLIKEHORSEBIZ stalked the pace while racing on the inside on the turn making a bid then came up empty in the end. KIEARA WISH was inside and saving ground on the turn, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch but was no menace. COLTON COUNTDOWN raced five wide on the turn then came up empty in the stretch. ZAP A PRINCE was unhurried early and raced three wide on the turn but was no factor. EARLY NOMINEE vied for the lead while inside, was hard used then stopped in the stretch. POWDERHORN HEAT vied for the lead while two wide, was hard used then

stopped in the stretch.
