MIRACLE LAKE was well placed and saved ground, awaited room at the top of the stretch while behind a wall of horses, split horses in mid stretch and drew off late. KIMBELL'S BLING allowed to settle early, rallied in the upper stretch five wide, put in her bid and was second best. CAPOTE'S CHARM vied for the lead on the inside throughout, held well in the stretch. BUENA FORTUNA (MEX) allowed to settle early, rallied in mid stretch and had a late gain. MOLLY MAGNOLIA pressed the pace for seven furlongs, weakened slightly in mid stretch. DIXIELAND PARADE well placed early, rallied at the quarter pole while between horses, put in her bid, then flattened out. KIPLING'S RED BIRD set a pressured pace, tired in the stretch. LENOX LANE was never a threat.
