CULINARY was settled in the early going while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied five wide on the far turn making a strong move to the front then was in a long sustained drive throughout the stretch drive to prove best in the end. LUCKY SABRE stalked the pace while three wide on the backstretch, rallied four wide on the far turn to gained a narrow lead in upper stretch then was in a long drive on the inside in the stretch but was outfinished in deep stretch. BALLROOM DEPUTY stalked the early pace while saving ground on the first turn then made a two wide bid on the far turn but came up empty in the stretch drive. BONNIE J. was void of early speed and settled while in the back of the pack, swung out five wide on the far turn then closed willingly in the stretch but was no threat late. MISS CONFUSION pressed the early pace while racing two wide, made a strong bid going into the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive. COOKIN'S CAST was unhurried early then raced four wide on the far turn and was no factor. CAPOTIADA set the early pace while under good handling then was used up and gave way on the far turn. TIMBER JONES was unhurried early and was no factor. OSWEGO stalked the pace while racing three wide, made a bid on the far turn then stopped badly in the stretch.
