RIZZI MONEY moved out in the middle of the field, raced three wide on the turn, rallied in upper stretch, closed fast to get the lead passing the sixteenth-pole then edged clear under good handling. WW CONQUISTADOR raced towards the rear of the field, went three to four wide on the turn and finished well for the place. SCREEN WRITER dueled for the lead, vied between rivals on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and weakened while able to hold the show. CONVALLARIA broke out a bit at the start, was rated off the early pace, moved in entering the turn, angled to the rail approaching the furlong marker and finished willingly but missed the minor awards. FORTUNE'S FOOL chased the pace, made a bid on the turn, battled into the final sixteenth and tired. DOMINIC'S RED BIRD angled in while ridden along, raced off the rail on the turn and lacked the needed response. MIDNIGHT EXPLOSION chased

the pace, raced four wide on the turn and gave way. UPTOWN ROCKET was ridden along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn and passed tired rivals. TATES MANDATE dueled for the lead, vied three wide on the turn and gave way. NOWURTAKN brushed with a rival at the start, raced off the pace, lacked room behind tiring rivals late and failed to threaten. FLAMBEAU MAN was hard ridden towards the front, saved ground on the turn, was in tight at the top of the stretch and stopped. JUSTAFIRECRACKER raced well back in the field, went four wide on the turn and was outrun. TRU DANCING brushed with a rival at the start and showed little. BUMPSTERDOSE was always outrun.
