**Footnotes**

TWO JAYS SECRET stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch on the inside, drew off late under firm handling. TAKSENT unhurried early, rallied in the upper stretch three wide, drew even in mid stretch and was outfinished late but was second best. SHOE SHOE SHOE stalked the pace four wide, rallied on the second turn and gained the lead, faltered in late stretch. TOES THE LINE well placed early, rallied on the second turn, put in his bid, then hung. MITHRANDIR (CHI) allowed to settle and saved ground, went evenly. SLEEVE raced in the second flight and passed tiring rivals. OLD CHUNK OF COAL set a pressured early pace, tired on the second turn. COOL'S PHIRE pressed the pace while between horses, then tired. DUSTY TUNNEL raced middle of the pack and was no threat. AFRICAN GRAY slow early, was no menace. BONNIE'S PROSPECT contended early, then gave way.
