DELIVERER dueled on the inside, shook clear at the top of the lane, drew off under left handed urging. FREDDIE ANTEROS dueled with the winner, could not match strides late but was second best. NORMANDY SHORE well placed while three wide, lacked a late response and went evenly. SHAOLIN allowed to settle early, had a mild bid while no threat. STICKCROSSMOUNTAIN wide early, was no menace. WEE BE GONE well placed and saved ground, had no rally. RICH JEWEL had good position for a half, faltered in late stretch. CHILE FRITO was never a threat. KITTEN IN A PINCH raced inside and dropped back.
