RELEASE THE MAGIC was settled then rallied on the turn while three wide, was staying three wide for the stretch drive and was up in the final strides. TIN TOP KID dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive and gamely dug in throughout the stretch but was outfinished at the wire while being second best. LAZER RED dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then was outfinished in deep stretch. CHRIS'EXPECTATIONS was allowed to settle then rallied two wide in the stretch but was no menace. FAMOUS MR. JONES was unhurried early then raced three wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch. ANTIOCH NATIVE was inside and saving ground on the turn but failed to menace. POETIC PROSPECT chased the early pace while racing two wide, made a bid then faltered in the stretch. RYALS trailed throughout.
