R MEMORIES was inside then taken back off the pace, rallied, and swung out to be four wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive and was best in the end. BREEZY KNOWL was allowed to settle in the early going, rallied three wide on the turn then mad a strong bid in the stretch but hung in late stretch. SLOWLY BUT SHIRLEY was unhurried early then swung out to be side in upper stretch then closed willingly in late stretch. GLEE ALEE was chasing the early pace then rallied three wide on the turn, gained the lead in mid stretch but could not last in the end. COUNTRY SOUL was unhurried early and raced three wide on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. PRANCY FANCY vied for the early lead while two wide, was hard used then faltered in the stretch drive. JOSEPH COUNTDOWN vied for the early lead then drew off while racing three wide on the turn, was sued up and weakened in the stretch. LUV DUMP vied for the lead while inside, was used up and gave way.
