REGINA'S MON was well placed near the inside, chased the pace on the far turn, rallied along the rail entering the final furlong and closed determinedly to get up late. RUM SHOOTER set the pace under steady pressure, vied inside on the far turn, battled gamely in the stretch and was denied. IDEALISM broke a step slow, raced three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch and closed gradually. BULLRINGER was off slow, settled well off the pace, waited behind rivals on the far turn, steadied while blocked passing the quarter-pole, came between rivals near the furlong marker and lacked the needed kick. THUNDER E. O. G. raced three wide on the first turn, settled between rivals, chased while three wide on the far turn and came up empty. DUSTY TUNNEL raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and also came up empty. KEY MOESAABE KID broke inward at the start, shifted three wide on the first turn, pressed the pace on the outside, drew even near the half-mile pole, dueled with RUM SHOOTER on the far turn and faded. WHITNEY WILLIE raced four wide on the first turn, lagged at the back of the field and was outrun.
