VALID STRIPES was allowed to settle in the early going then rallied three wide on the turn, was in a strong drive on the outside and powered up to the front and proved best in the end. CHIEF OF AFFAIRS was well placed while racing four wide into the turn, rallied in the middle of the turn then powered up to take command in mid stretch but was outfinished in the end. RANGER DANGER was well placed while racing three wide into the turn, moved up to take command then was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. PACIFIC TSUNAMI was unhurried early then made a mild rally while three wide in the stretch but was no menace in the end. GRAND TEJAS was unhurried early then made a late gain in the stretch while four wide but was no threat. GOLD COYOTE duelled for the early lead while two wide, was hard used then faltered in the stretch. GOOSEY MOOSE was unhurried early then made a three wide moved on the turn but was no threat. WILD SERVE was three wide into the turn, was used up then faltered in the stretch. SERGEANT SAXTON duelled for the early lead while inside, was used up and stopped.
