SKIP A SMILE was allowed to settle in the early going while inside, started a run heading into the far turn then moved out to be three wide in upper stretch, was in a strong drive then proved best in the end. BRENTWOOD BULLET dueled for the lead while two wide in the early pace, assumed command on the run down the backstretch, drew off on the far turn then dug in gamely throughout the stretch but was outfinished in the end. WAJIR ON ME was allowed to settle while racing on the inside, saved ground on the far turn then was gaining ground in late stretch but was no threat to the top two. SCRAPPY ROO was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn, made a bid to mid stretch but came up empty in late stretch. THEATRICAL'S HALO was unhurried early then rallied three wide on the far turn then moved out to be five wide in upper stretch but was no threat. VALID MESSAGE was unhurried early then started a run on the far turn, swung out to be five wide at the top of the stretch but was no menace. DUBAI FALCON was unhurried early then raced four wide on the far turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. MIDWAY TAP dueled for the lead while inside, was used up then gave way heading into the far turn.
