VISTA RIDGE was unhurried early then rallied on the turn, was three wide in the stretch and closed with a rush and was along in time. DORVAN was chasing the pace then rallied on the turn while two wide, gained command in mid stretch and drew off but could not last in late stretch. ARANUBA set a pressured pace while inside, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. OUR DIVA FACTOR chased the pace while inside, was saving ground on turn making a bid then weakened in the stretch drive. ARCTIC LOGGER was four wide into the turn then angled inside to save ground in the middle of the turn, moved back out to be four wide in upper stretch but came up empty in late stretch. NAFISS was bumped hard at the start then hustled along to chase the pace, was used up then weakened. MONSTER STORM was allowed to settle then failed to menace. GAMBINI was bumped hard at the start then ducked in and was rank in the early going, raced greenly on the turn then found a stride in the stretch. UNCLE GRINGO was inside into the turn, was blocked behind rivals then dropped back and lacked a rally. GENERAL SLEW broke in at the start and was bumped hard then was rank throughout while being outrun.
