SOUPEX EX set a pressured pace from the start, was in a long drive and gamely dug in then drew off in late stretch. ARCTIC CHILL was allowed to settled then raced two wide into the turn, rallied three wide in upper stretch making a bid then hung in late stretch but held the place safe in the end. F P REIGN'S LAD was allowed to settle then rallied five wide on the turn, was gaining ground and finished well in the end. J W FLYER was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground to finish well. BIG BAD BABE was unhurried early then made a late rally while three wide in the stretch but was no menace. IT'S SNOW DEVIL was two wide on the turn then moved to the inside for the stretch drive but was no threat in the end. ABBY BOY pressed the pace while two wide into the turn, was in a long drive in the stretch then weakened in the end. AT FULL PELT rallied four wide on the turn then bore out in upper stretch and faltered in the drive. TEXAS IKE was seven wide on the turn and failed to menace. JUBAL EARLY showed good early speed from the inside, was inside on the turn then faltered in the stretch drive. NO PRESSURE was unhurried early while racing three wide on the turn and was no threat. HES REED was outrun.
