SLEET'S APRIL ROSE was away alertly and quickly set the pace, was nicely rated on the front end, led throughout and remained clear while being ridden out. DIAMOND GLORY chased the winner throughout, could not gain in the stretch but was second best. LINDA'S ROSE broke slowly and was allowed to settle, had a mild stretch bid. LIDLOVE well placed and saved ground, steadied slightly at the three eighth pole and went evenly. BELLA RACHEL had good position while wide, lacked a rally. UNO KATERINO raced middle of the pack and was no threat. BIRD IN THE STREET had brief foot and was through early. LADY MELROSE was no factor. LOVE TO WIN flashed brief foot and gave way.
