**Footnotes**

CHRISTMAS LILY was taken outside going into the first turn to duel for the lead while being well rated, assumed command on the far turn then gamely dug in while inside in the stretch, was headed in mid stretch and dug in to regain the lead in late stretch and proved best in a game effort. PLAID stalked the pace while inside and under good handling, rallied three wide on the far turn to go up and duel for the lead from the outside of CHRISTMAS LILY and put a head in front in mid stretch but was unable to sustain that bid in deep stretch. I. B.'S HALO stalked the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, made a four wide bid on the far turn then was no threat to the top two in late stretch while clearly best of the rest. SWEET IDEA dueled for the lead while inside then gamely dug in on the far turn but weakened in the stretch drive. BARBETTE chased the pace while two wide on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn and failed to menace in the stretch. OLMOSTA was unhurried early and settled then saved ground on the far turn and was no threat in the stretch. CULINARY raced three wide on the backstretch then made a bid while five wide on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch drive. DADDY'S PETUNIA raced four wide on the first turn while being settled then failed to menace.
