MYSTERY BLESSING was allowed to settle, rallied in mid stretch six wide, closed with a rush and drew off late under left handed urging. WOKE UP PRAYING set the pace and dueled on the lead, gained a clear lead in mid stretch, could not hold off the winner but was second best. EMPRESS ELTISH never far back, rallied through the stretch on the inside and finished willingly. ZAMITA slow early, swung wide in the upper stretch and found her best stride late. CAJUN FRENCH never far back, lacked a late response and went evenly. GIRLS TRIP good position until mid stretch, lacked a late kick. BYARS CLASS allowed to settle four wide, failed to menace. DANCE DEEYA DANCE pressed the pace for six furlongs, gave way in the stretch.
