### Footnotes

FLY THE RED EYE was stalking the pace while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied on the far turn then was in a all out drive and proved best in the end. WHY BILL WHY was well placed while racing two wide in the early part, moved up and dueled for the lead while two wide into the far turn, dug in gamely throughout the stretch but was outfinished in the end. CHARLIE'S PHANTASY was stalking the pace while between rivals on the backstretch, made a bid on the far turn but was no menace in the stretch drive. SASSY MAVERICK was allowed to settled then rallied four wide on the far turn making a bid then faltered in late stretch. JAZZ PARTY stalked the pace while inside then saved ground on the far turn making a bid but came up empty in the end. SPIDERMAN RIDGE was unhurried early then failed to menace. KID KIOWA set the early pace while inside then was collared heading into the far turn, dueled for the lead but was used up and gave way in the stretch drive.
