PAPAW BODIE was settled while racing three wide on the backstretch, waited while between rivals heading into the far turn then made a quick response when opening occurred at the top of the stretch, blasted through between rivals and was clearly best in the end. PROCEED BEE was allowed to settle while racing three wide on the backstretch, rallied heading into the far turn then was gaining ground on the outside to be second best. LITTLE WAGON set a pressured pace from the start, dueled for the lead from the inside on the far turn then bore out in upper stretch and weakened in late stretch. IOYA BIGTIME pressed the pace while racing two wide then moved up and dueled for the lead while two wide on the far turn, was hard used then faltered in the stretch. AND MUSIC CAME was stalking the pace while racing two wide on the backstretch, was shuffled back heading into the far turn then was no menace in the stretch drive. COL. WRIGHT was unhurried early and no factor in the stretch while wide. DAKOTA GYPSY was settled while inside, made a middle move heading into the far turn then faltered in the stretch drive.
