LUKE THE DUKE was settled in the early going then rallied o the turn, was five wide in upper stretch and in a strong drive, powered to the front in late stretch to be best in the end. LONESOME GUY set the early pace then drew off in upper stretch but could not last in late stretch. SMOKINLEX was inside and saving ground on the turn, rallied two wide in the stretch then finished well in the end. PRIMAL JONES was four wide on the turn making a bid then flattened out in the stretch. JUST EXPECTATIONS chased early pace while three wide, was used up then gave way. STREET LIFE BLUES was unhurried early and was no factor. POWDERHORN HEAT was inside and saving ground on the turn then faltered in the drive. IRISH DARCY chased the early pace while two wide, was used up then stopped.
