SCHRAMBERG was allowed to settle while racing inside on the first turn, stayed inside on the run down the backstretch then started a run heading into the far turn, swung out to be three wide in upper stretch and was in a strong drive then quickly drew off in late stretch to be clearly best in the end. SOUTHERN ANTHEM was unhurried early on while inside, rallied on the far turn while four wide then was gaining ground in late stretch but was no threat to the winner. STATELY VICTOR was unhurried early on then inside, rallied on the far turn while inside then swung out to be four wide in mid stretch and closed well but was too late in the end. AND MUSIC CAME dueled for the early lead while inside, was in a long sustained drive then weakened in late stretch. DEPUTIFORMER stalked the early pace while racing three wide then moved up on the backstretch to vied for the lead, was in a long drive then faltered in the stretch drive. FIFTEEN LOVE was unhurried early then raced two wide on the far turn but failed to menace. SPINNING TOUCH was unhurried early while racing three wide, was three wide on the far turn then was no factor in the stretch. BARRIER REEF was hustled along to pressed the pace while two wide, then vied for the lead from between rivals on the backstretch, was used up and stopped when entering the far turn.
