QUEENLAND set a pressured pace in the early going then drew clear in upper stretch and was ridden out in late stretch while clearly best. DONEGAL GOLD pressed the early pace while two wide, was hard used then weakened in the stretch while holding the place safe in the end. REIGHNING ANGEL broke out at the start and bumped hard then made a mild gain in the stretch but was outfinished for the place in the end. BETA BELIEVE broke slowly from the gate then was inside and saving ground on the turn, made a mild rally in the stretch and was no menace. FATE'S TREASURE on the inside and saving ground then was no menace. FLY AWAY DOVE raced on the inside on the turn and was no threat. BAILEYS QUICK DRAW was bumped at the start then raced four wide on the turn and was no factor. CUTIE TWO SHOES was pinched back at the start then was three wide on the turn and no factor in the stretch.
