### Footnotes

NAEVUS GIRL moved up to duel for the lead on the backstretch and turn, drew off in late stretch and was much the best. LAST WAGER was allowed to settle while racing three wide, rallied in upper stretch but was on second best in the end. FAST ACTING CAT broke sharply from the gate then was taken in hand heading into the turn, dueled for the lead from the inside then was in a long drive but weakened in the stretch. SMOOTH SEA broke out at the start then was moved to the inside heading into the turn, saved ground but failed to menace in the stretch. CALIROSE was forced out at the start then raced two wide on the turn but was no threat. DEBBIE WAS MINE chased the early pace from the inside, was used up and gave way in the stretch.
