THAT'S OUR ROMEO had good position while four wide, lacked a late bid and went evenly. HUCKLEBERRY LARRY allowed to settle early while wide, had a mild rally late while no threat. BO DEVIL well placed and saved ground, lacked a late kick. MR. ROCKER never far back, lacked a late response. SONNYS CROWN well placed and saved ground, had no bid. COUNTRY NUGGET allowed to settle, failed to menace. SAMIRI CASE was never a threat. MOON LIT NIGHT raced mid pack early, then tired. MR. E. T. was no factor. HI TECKNO RUSH well placed for a half, gave way in the stretch.
