Footnotes

SEA MASTER set a well rated pace in the early going, drew off in upper stretch then was kept to task in late stretch and held sway in the end. MOUNT ISTAN was saving ground on the turn, was inside for the stretch drive and gaining ground to finished strong and was second best. JONES PLAYER pressed the pace while racing two wide, was hard used then weakened in late stretch. BENCHIDY was bumped hard by BROTHER CHUCK soon after the start, was hustled along and four wide into the turn, rallied to mid stretch then flattened out in late stretch. KASTANSHA was two wide into the turn, made a four wide bid in upper stretch then raced evenly in the end. REPENT'S RED BIRD had his head turned at the break and was left, was hustled along then swung out to be six wide in the middle of the turn and tired in the drive. ROCK A BY ZAP showed brief foot while three wide then dropped back. BULL PEN raced three wide on the turn and was no factor. BROTHER CHUCK lugged in soon after the start and bumped hard with BENCHIDY causing the rider to nearly fall off and losing his irons, recovered the irons then trailed the rest of the way.
