SUPER STRUGGLER dueled for the lead while racing two wide, was in a long all out drive and prevailed in the end. BE A RESIDENT dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long all out drive throughout but was outfinished in late stretch. SNOW CAP was settled early on then rallied three wide in upper stretch, was gaining ground in late stretch to finish well. TWO JAYS SECRET was three wide on the turn then made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat. WILDCAT was inside early on then bore out on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch. COOK'S NOOK raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace in the stretch. K. B. ALEX was unhurried early and was no factor. GLASS MACHINE was two wide on the turn then was carried out at the quarter pole, angled inside in upper stretch but weakened in the drive.
