Footnotes

RIGGER sent along to set the pace, dueled for the lead on the turn while inside, drew off in late stretch then just lasted in the end. BADGE OF KROLL was unhurried early and staying to the inside, saved ground on the turn then moved out to be two wide and closed fast in late stretch while splitting rivals to be up for the place. PONO was settled in the early going then came up the inside and scraped the rail in the middle of the turn, rallied willingly in the stretch and finished well in the end. SEEKING TO RUN rallied five wide on the turn, was gaining ground in late stretch and finished well. OKIE LIMIT was unhurried early in the early going, rallied seven wide on the turn, was gaining ground in late stretch but was too late. BEACH ASSAULT was hustled along into the turn and dueled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then weakened in late stretch. PEACE OF GOLD was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be seven wide in upper stretch and made a late gain. BAILANDO chased the early pace while inside, was used up and gave way. ZAP A PRINCE was settled while acing between rivals, was blocked behind rivals on the turn and shuffled back then moved to the inside in the stretch and failed to menace. WASP raced four wide on the turn and failed to menace. FIRESIDE MR JOHN raced five wide on the turn, was used up then gave way. MASTER JEHU raced three wide on the turn and lacked a rally. IRISH DARCY showed brief foot and stopped. MORE SPACE was through after a half and stopped.
