ISHARARULER was away alertly and quickly set the pace, was nicely rated on the front, led throughout responded when asked and widened late under strong handling. GOSPEL HOUR chased the winner throughout, could not gain late but was clearly second best. DIA PERFECTO (MEX) allowed to settle and saved ground, had a mild rally on the inside. MIDTOWN GROOM unhurried early, had a mild bid while no threat. RUNAWAY CRYPTO slow early, passed tiring rivals. BIG RED OKIE well placed three wide, tired in the stretch. SIXTO CALIXTO (MEX) allowed to settle, failed to menace. LENOX LANE was never a threat. ROLL CALL never far back, had no rally. GOLDENEXPECTATIONS well placed on the inside, tired on the second turn. MEANT TO BE HERE good position for five furlongs, gave way on the second turn.
