NORMANDY SHORE showed good early speed to set the pace, was well handled then drew clear in upper stretch and was kept to task in late stretch. SHOE SHOE SHOE was settled in the early going then rallied while two wide in upper stretch, split rivals and was gaining ground but was no threat to the winner. JAKE WIL GALLOP bobbled at the start then was unhurried early, started a run on the turn and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch then made a mild gain in the stretch. PRACTICE TEE raced three wide on the turn, made a bid in upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. MEAN DEMAND was inside and saving ground on the turn but was no threat in the stretch drive. TEXAS TYCOON chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up and faltered in the stretch. NUTTYBOOM threw his head at the start then chased the early pace from the inside, was used up and stopped in the stretch drive.
