FRIENDLY LADY chased the early pace while racing three wide into the turn, rallied on the turn and moved up to take command, drew clear in mid stretch then was clearly best in the end. SPRING JADE was unhurried early then rallied four wide on turn, was gaining ground willingly while four wide and was second best in the end. SHY TEMPER chased the early pace while racing two wide, rallied on the turn making a bid then weakened in the stretch drive. MISS KATY LAKE was unhurried early while inside, stayed inside on the turn then made a mild gain in the stretch but was no menace. KEELANN was settled then rallied four wide on the turn, made a bid to mid stretch then flattened out in the end. TRIKSTA was unhurried early while three wide on the turn, moved in to be two wide for the stretch drive but was no threat. MADELINEVILLE was unhurried early while racing five wide on the backstretch, stayed five wide in the stretch and made a late gain but was no threat. CAP DANZER showed good early speed from the gate, was used up and stopped in the stretch. FIVE STAR GLORY was unruly in the gate then racing on the inside and stopped in the stretch.
