TIE RODETTE set the early pace while being pressured, drew off in upper stretch and led throughout while being kept to a drive in the end. PRANCY FANCY was allowed to settle then rallied on the turn, was three wide in the stretch and was up for the place in the end. GLEE ALEE was settled then rallied on the turn while four wide, made a bid in upper stretch then weakened and was outfinished for the place in the end. BURNT STAR chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, made a bid then faltered in the stretch. LOVE TO WIN was unhurried early and saving ground on the turn, swung out to be five wide in upper stretch and made a late rush but was no threat. SUGAR PRINCESS was two wide on the turn then failed to menace. MINISTERS FIRST raced four wide on the turn and lacked a rally. PANAMA CITY JOY raced five wide on the turn and was no factor. ROJA'S HERO chased the early pace while inside, was used up and stopped badly in the stretch.
