DUSTY TUNNEL was settled early then started a run going into the far turn, rallied three wide on the far turn and gained command coming out of the far turn, was headed in mid stretch and gamely dug in to prove best in the end. BULLRINGER was unhurried early then rallied four wide on the far turn, gained command in mid stretch but failed to sustained that bid in the final seventy yards. MARQUET GOLD set the early pace while being well rated, drew clear on the backstretch then weakened in mid stretch. KANATA RIDGE saved ground on both turns while under good handling, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the stretch. LEATHAL STING chased the early pace while racing two wide, was used up and gave way on the far turn. LITTLE BRICK LANE raced four wide on the first turn and failed to menace. GLENS DEVIL DUE trailed throughout while being outrun.
