WHEN WILLY WIN was never far back early, rallied in the upper stretch four wide, closed determienly and drew off under strong handling. SWINGIN CAT dueled on the lead from the inside, was outfinished late but finished gamely for second. THEZIMMAN unhurried early, rallied through the lane on the inside and finished well. BLACK MARKET BRICK dueled on the lead, faltered in mid stretch. FLY THE RED EYE well placed three wide, went evenly late. GRIND never far back, lacked a late response. TIZ BIZ pressed the pace for six furlongs, flattened out in the stretch. HELLO BUD wide early, was no threat. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP never far back while three wide, gave way on the second turn.
