ANEW RUMOR was unhurried early on then started a run heading into the far turn, rallied four wide in upper stretch, was in a long drive and proved best in the end. THE PROGRAM was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while three wide, was in a long drive but hung in late stretch. HALIFAX FLYER was allowed to settled then rallied on the far turn while two wide, made a bid then came up empty in the stretch drive. ZAPTITUDE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch but was no menace. B'WANAGOLDMINE was unhurried early then rallied on the far turn while five wide, made a bid then flattened out in the drive. WIMBLEDON'S FIRE set the early pace, was used up on the backstretch then gave way in the stretch. OVERNIGHT FLIGHT chased the early pace while inside, made a bid on the far turn then faltered in the drive. STREET LIFE BLUES chased the pace then made a bid two wide into the far turn but gave way in the stretch.
