STORM TUNER stalked the pace, rallied in the upper stretch, prevailed late after a long stretch battle. SERGEANT SAXTON set the early pace, was hooked in mid stretch, fought back gamely and just missed. TATNALL STREET well placed while three wide, went evenly in the stretch. BLAZEN SUMMER allowed to settle early, improved his position while no threat. INTERLACHEN raced middle of the pack and was no threat. TYLER ROSEMAN saved ground and was never a threat. EAGLE TWO HUNDRED allowed to settle early, failed to menace. BENITO had good early position and was through after a half.
