QUEENLAND stalked the early pace while racing three wide into the turn, rallied on the outside to gained command in upper stretch, drew off in late stretch then was kept to task in late stretch. JUST CUVEE was unhurried early then rallied and moved out to be four wide in upper stretch, closed fast in late stretch to be second best. BROADWAY ALI dueled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then tired in mid stretch. TIN TIN TINSEL had her heels clipped soon after the start then stalked the pace from the inside, saved ground on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. SAND RIDGE EXPRESS dueled for the lead while two wide, was hard used then faltered in the stretch. A DOSE OF HEAT raced two wide on the turn but was no factor. F P ELECTRIC STORM bore in and clipped heels of TIN TIN TINSEL soon after the start then was settled, bore out on the turn while racing four wide and was no menace in the stretch. PEACH MONEY was four wide into the turn and was no factor.
