REVEAU S. dueled for the lead on the rail, drew clear at the top of the stretch, lasted late under strong handling. ANDREW'S ALLOWANCE was unhurried early, rallied through the stretch four wide, finished well was up for second and bled. COAHUILA well placed and saved ground, finished willingly. FIREBALL'S ACE had good position throughout, lacked a late kick and went evenly. TOTAL POWER raced middle of the pack early, had a mild bid in the stretch while no threat. PRINCE TYLER never far back while four wide, lacked a late response. BELVER dueled on the lead for a half with the winner, gave way in the stretch. MOONCOIN CAT was no factor. DANCINGINTHESLEET had brief foot and tired.
