RICH JEWEL dueled on the lead from the inside, remained hooked in mid stretch, drew clear late under strong handling. CHILE FRITO well placed and saved ground, rallied in the stretch on the inside and was up for second. NORTH OF ALASKA never far back early, rallied four wide in the lane, finished well and was gaining. BEST AFFAIR set a pressured pace, weakened in late stretch. PRINCE EDDINGTON allowed to settle early, rallied in the stretch and had a late gain. BUBBA KIP vied for the lead, weakened in the stretch. I AM TARZAN well placed early, lacked a late response and went evenly. EL CHELERO had good position, lacked a late kick. BAILANDO was never a threat. CAT RULER was outrun on the inside.
