BIG TONY was allowed to settled then started a run on the turn, swung out to be six wide in upper stretch hen powered to the front in late stretch and proved best in the end. SILVER NICKEL vied for the lead while four wide from entering the turn to mid stretch and gamely dug throughout the stretch drive but weakened in deep stretch. JACKRABBIT FAST vied for the lead while five wide on the turn, dug in gamely in the stretch but tired in late stretch. SIR JAIME broke slowly then was taken to the inside and hustled along and vied for the lead while inside on the turn, dug in gamely but tired in late stretch. DEACON BOB was unhurried early then found a best stride in late stretch. DR SWIFT vied for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then gave way in mid stretch. PRETTY FASHIONABLE vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, was in a long drive then faltered in late stretch.
