FAST FLIGHT TONITE was well placed then vied for the lead while three wide into the turn, gained command then was in a long drive, dug in gamely and proved best in the end. TIGER'S SPLENDOR was settled then rallied three wide on the turn, made a bid to mid stretch but flattened out in late stretch. BLUES IN THE GRASS was unhurried early then was four wide on the turn, made a mild rally in the stretch but was no threat in the end. MISS GOSSIP was well placed while racing inside, saved ground on the turn then failed to menace in the stretch. ISABELLA THE LADY was hustled along the inside and vied for the lead heading into the turn, was used up then faltered. FIVE STAR GLORY was very fractious in the starting gate then was two wide in the early bid, was through after a half and stopped in late stretch. A DOSE OF HEAT ducked out at the start then was outrun.
