DIRECT FIRE vied for the lead while three wide on the backstretch, gained command heading into the turn then drew off in upper stretch and was kept to task in late stretch while clearly best in the end. CITY NAMED GLORY was vying for the early lead while inside, was shuffled back on the turn then came again three wide in the stretch, made a bid but was no threat to the winner while being second best. FLY THE RED EYE vied for the early lead while two wide, was in a long drive but weakened in late stretch. HEAVY AS METAL was allowed to settle then raced three wide on the turn but was no menace in the stretch. VOLTURI was unhurried early then was inside for the stretch drive but was no threat. COSTAMUCHO raced five wide on the run down the backstretch, was used up and faltered. ANEW RUMOR was unhurried early then raced two wide in the stretch and was no threat. GOLDEN FLASHBACK vied for the early lead while four wide, was used up and gave way on the turn. AGREATFATHER was inside on the turn and no factor. BEAU'S LEGEND was four wide on the turn and outrun.
